YOUTH GROUPS REOPENING

Our student ministry will resume youth group meetings at the end of June. Middle school (MS) youth group will resume meeting weekly on Wednesday, June 24, from 6:00-8:00 p.m. High school (HS) youth group will resume meeting weekly on Sunday, June 28, from 6:00-8:15 p.m.

Student ministry functions & meetings, unless otherwise communicated, will meet at RiverValley Church (1331 High Ave, Oshkosh).

All students entering grades 6-12 for the 2020-2021 school year are invited to participate in our student ministry! At the beginning of summer, we “promote” our students to the next grade. This means that all students are viewed one grade higher than what they were prior to the beginning of summer.

For example:

- A student who was in 5th grade during the 2019-2020 school year is viewed as a 6th grader in our student ministry after the end of the school year. Therefore, a student who has just finished 5th grade is invited to join our student ministry and youth group through the summer.
- A student who was in 8th grade during the 2019-2020 school year is viewed as a 9th grader (freshman) at the end of the recently finished school year. Therefore, a student who has just finished 8th grade is invited to begin attending the HS youth group on Sunday nights.
- A student who was in 12th grade during the 2019-2020 school year is viewed as a graduate at the end of the school year. Traditionally we have allowed graduates to continue attending HS youth group through the summer after they graduate, since most don't have a college ministry option available to them yet. Any graduate who wishes to return to HS youth group through August is welcome to do so.
